

**Office of Forest Seed
In Poland**



- 1999 - Council Directive 1999/105 / EC on the marketing of forest reproductive material (LMR)

2001 - Polish Act on FRM

May 1, 2004 - with the Polish accession to the EU came into force Act on FRM

September 15, 2004 - Office of Forest Seed began operations

December 2004 - BNL received the internal records seed base of National Forests - the beginning of the functioning of the National Register of FBM

OFS tasks:

- National Registry and shortened list of FBM register of certificates of origin FRM Register of Providers of FRM
- official controls of providers and managers LMP



OFS issues:

- certificate of origin for FRM
import licenses of FRM from countries
outside the European Union

 - III part – 8 789 (1 761 ha)

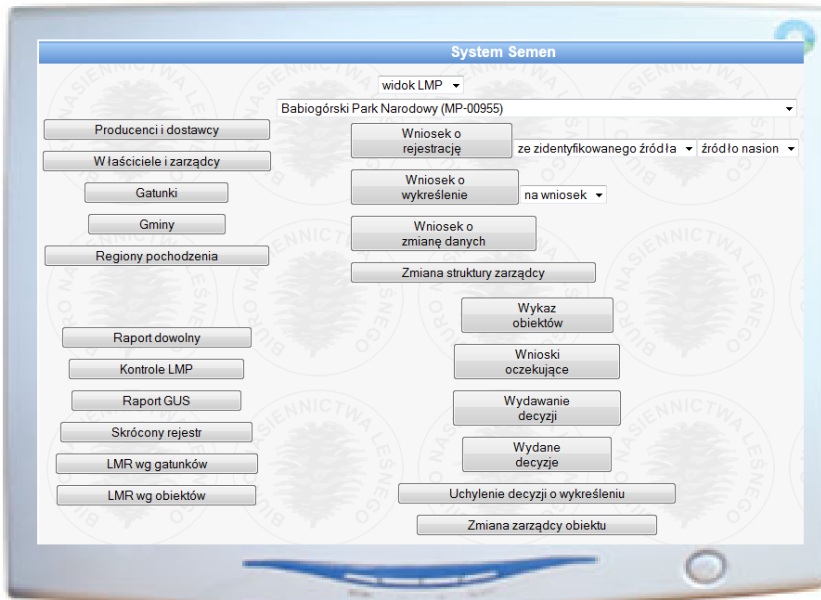


FRM production

- **issued 39 000 of FRM certificates of origin**

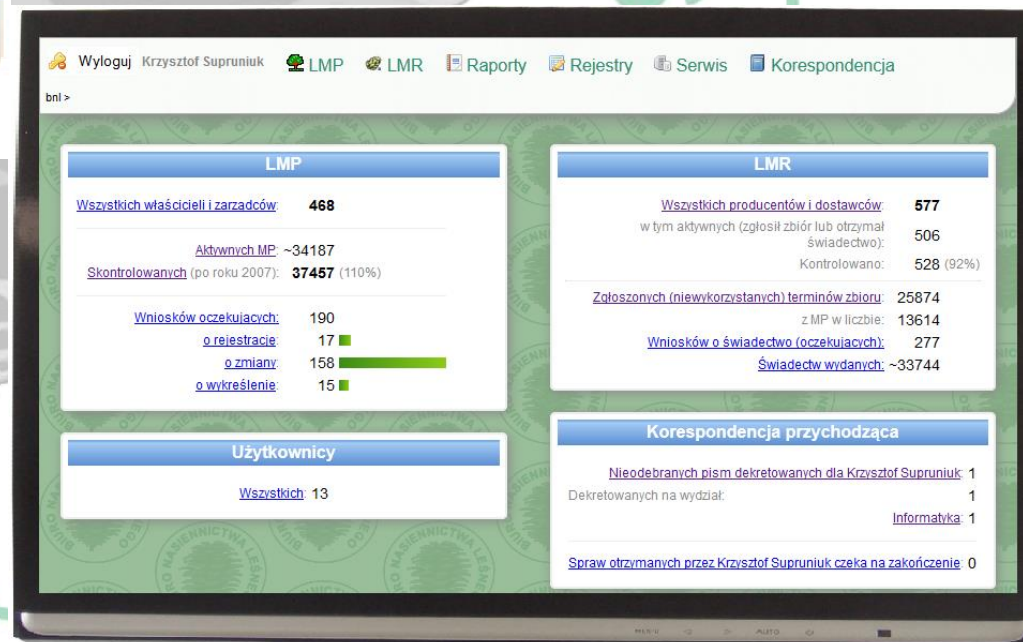


System SEMEN
